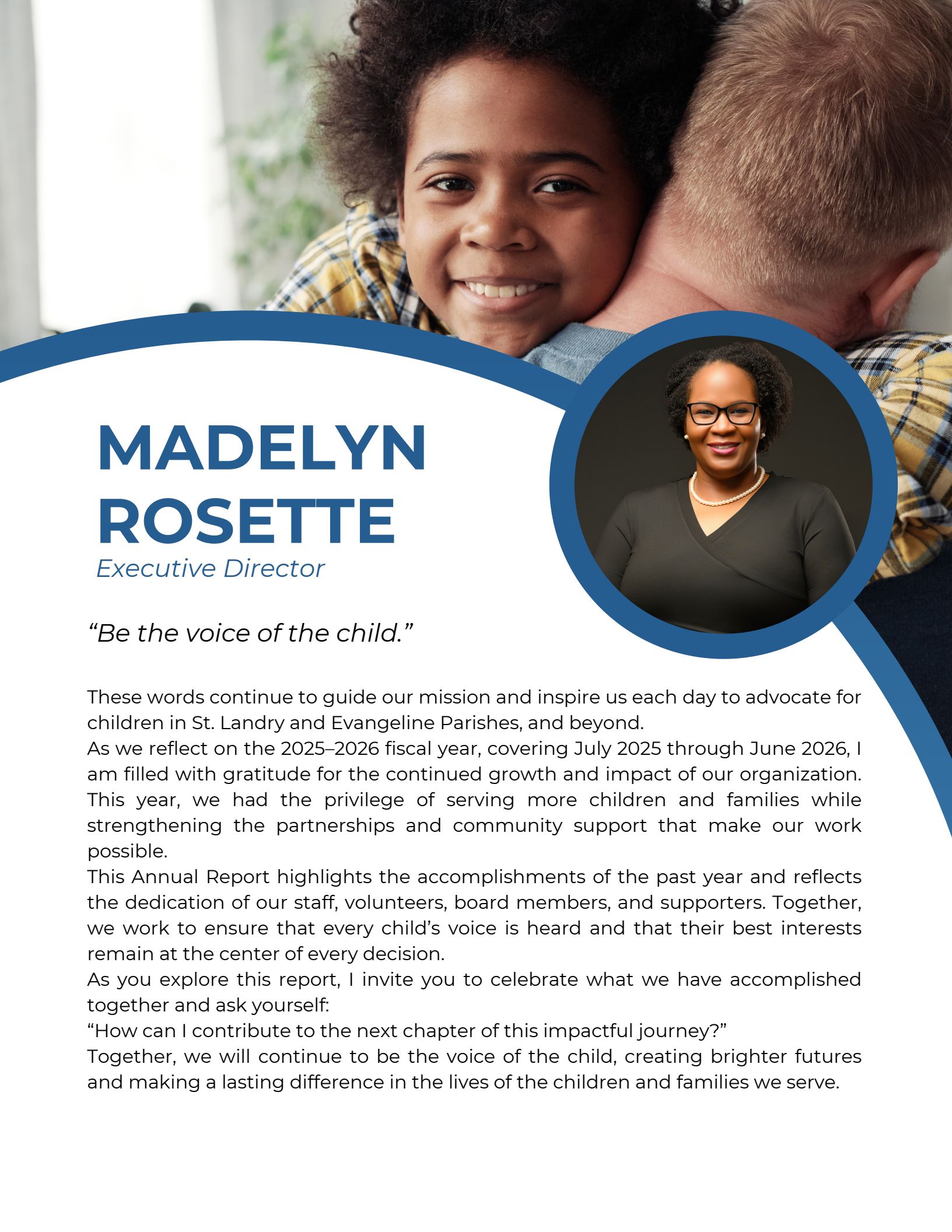

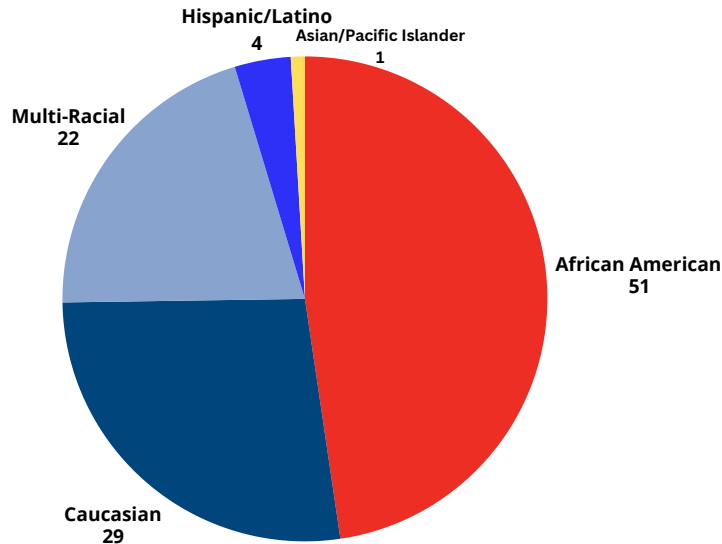

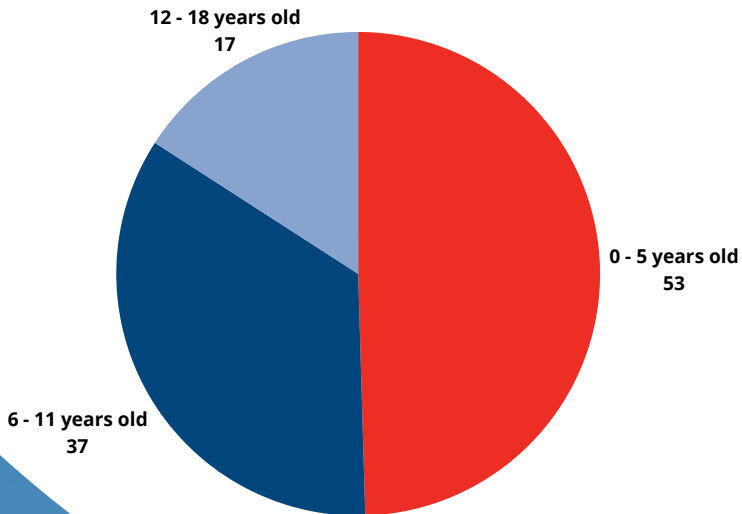

Demographics for Children Assigned to Volunteers

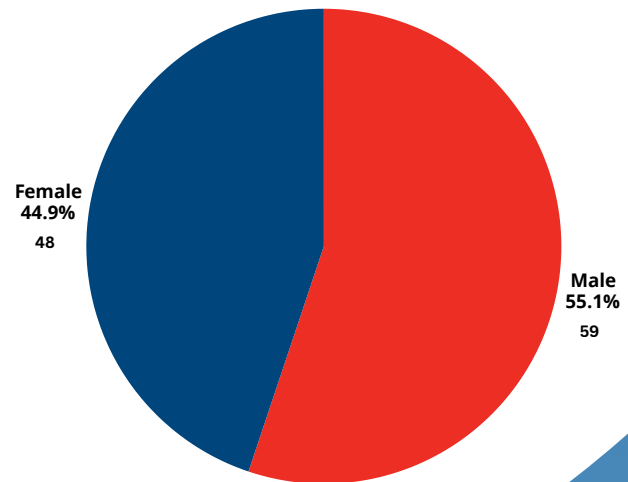

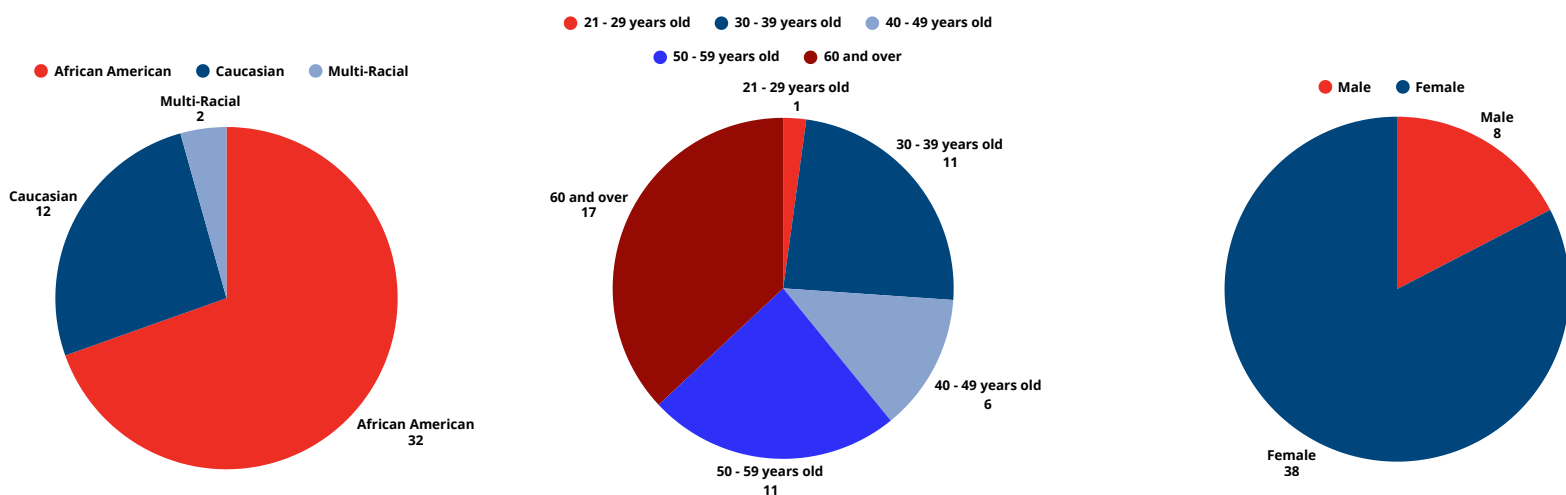
From July 1, 2025-June 30, 2026

cases.

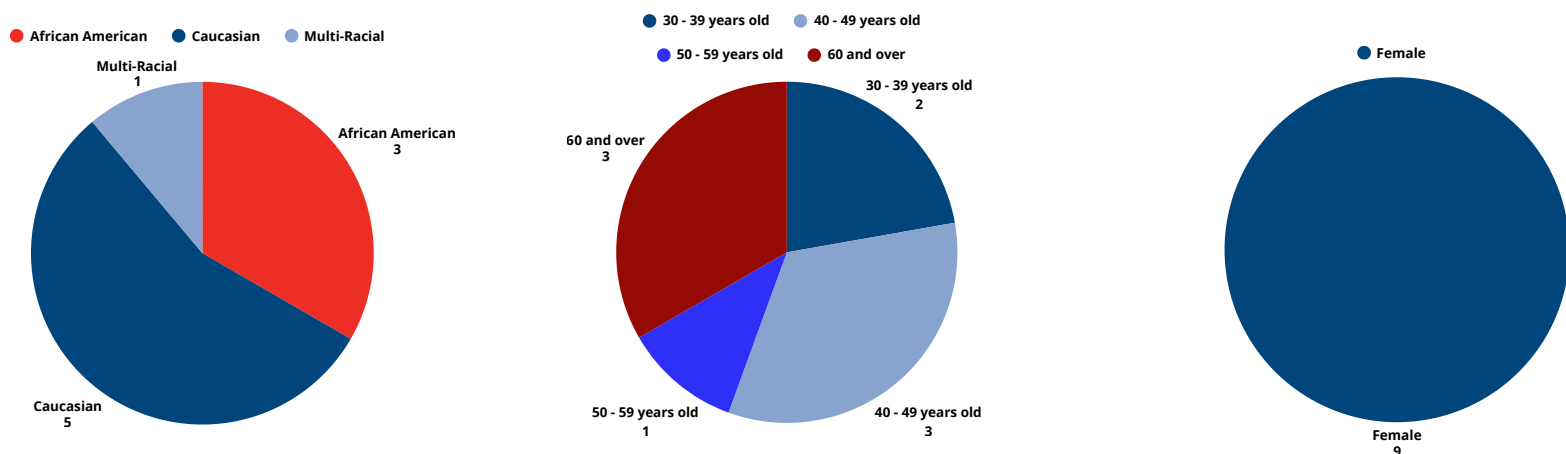

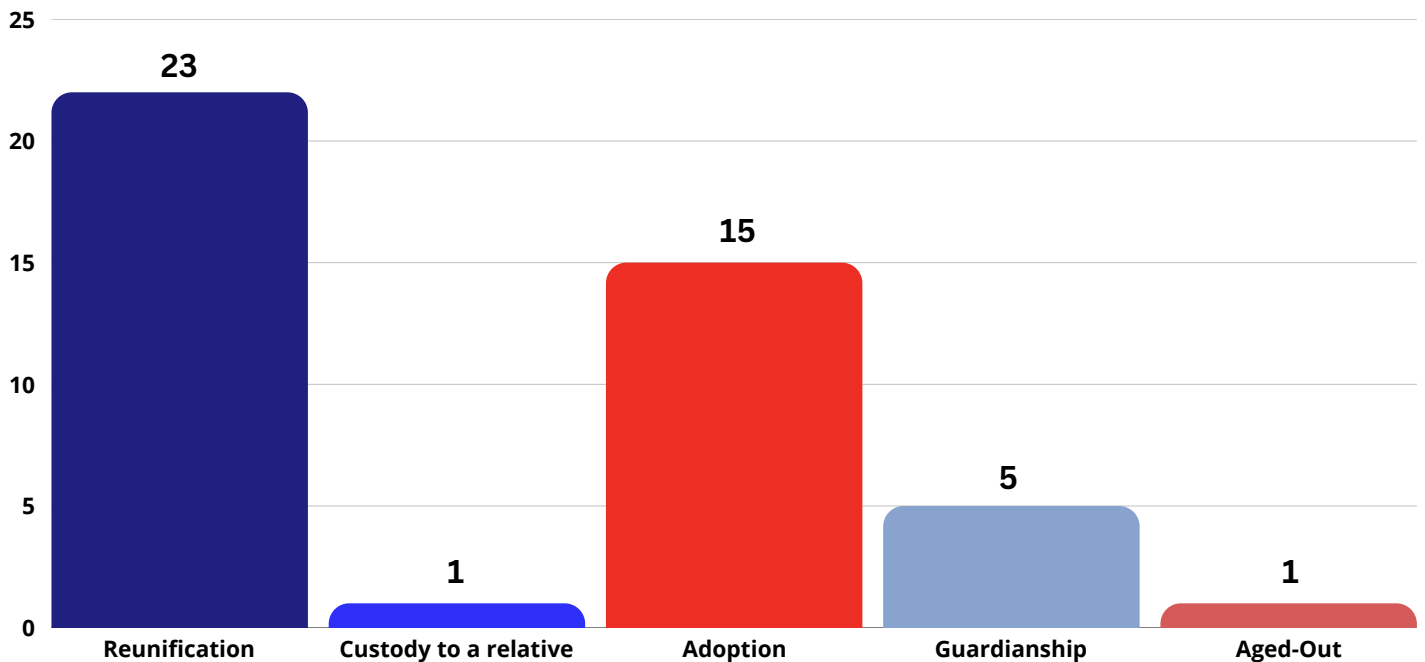

Reasons for Case Closures

Between July 2025 and June 2026, CASA of St. Landry-Evangeline, Inc. closed 46 cases, with 96% of the children finding permanency with family.
